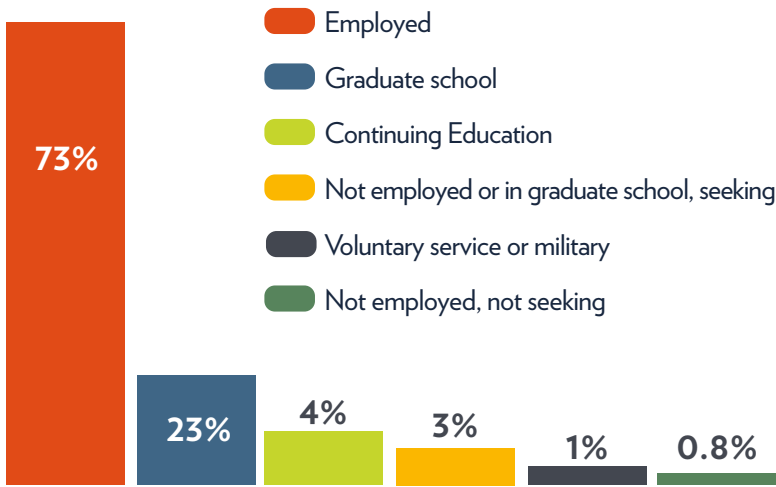


GRADUATE REPORT

Note: Percentages exceed 100% because survey responders could select multiple responses

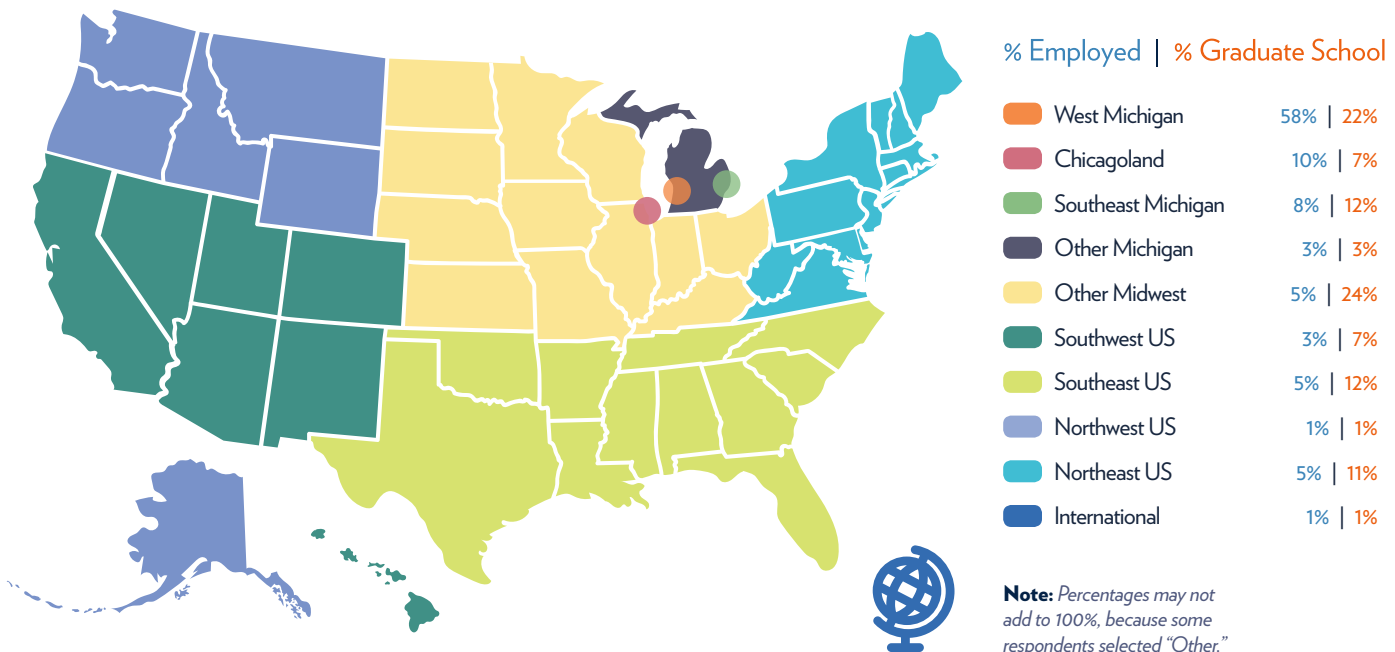

This study is administered annually by the Frost Center for Data and Research, Alumni and Family Engagement, the Boerigter Center for Calling and Career, and Admissions. Alumni are contacted 5-6 months after graduation by email, mail and telephone. This year we had a knowledge rate of 67.7%, with 323 survey responses, 101 from LinkedIn and 51 from the National Student Clearinghouse. 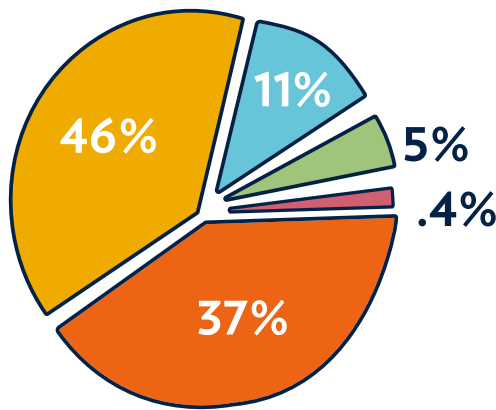

Class of 2022 Employment Satisfaction

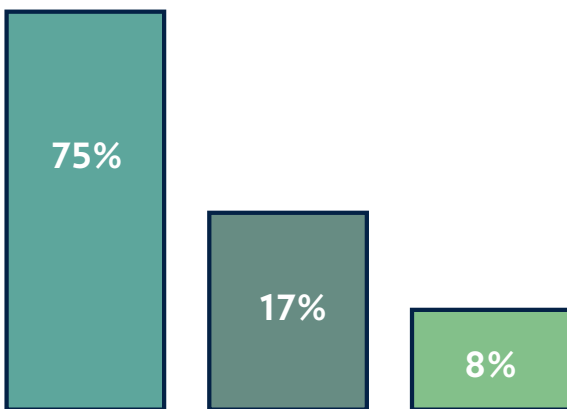

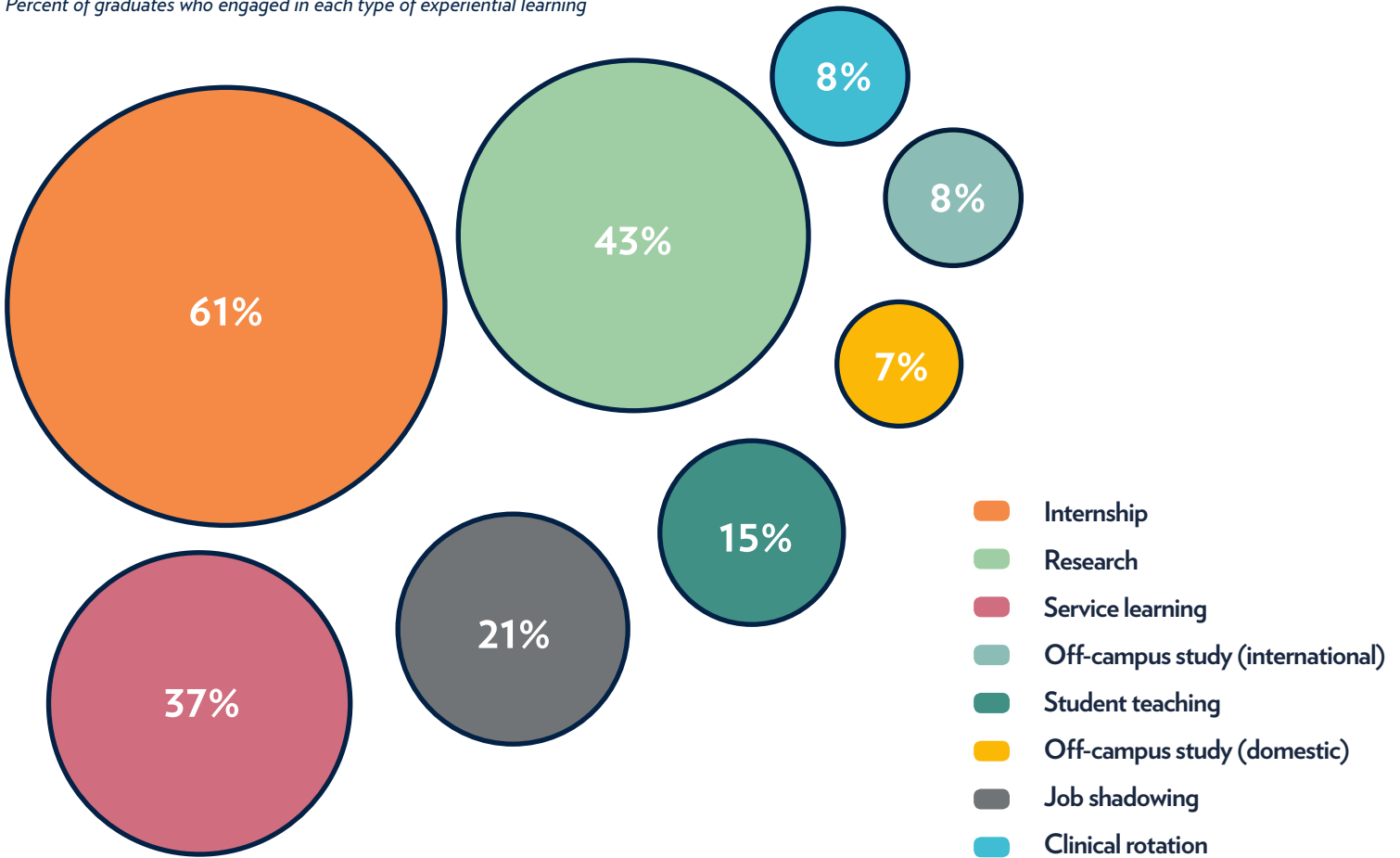
